



NORWALK PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM

List of Acceptable Forms of Identification



To get a Norwalk Public Library System card, applicant must present
One (1) type of identification from section **A**
 or
Two (2) types of identification from section **B**

A
THE FOLLOWING IDs ARE ACCEPTABLE ALONE, IF THEY ARE SIGNED, VALID AND CURRENT:
Connecticut Driver's License with Current Norwalk Address
Connecticut Photo ID with current Norwalk address
US passport with current Norwalk Address (Some passports do not list an address, in which case a proof of residency is needed)

TWO (2) IDs ARE REQUIRED: ONE (1) FROM EACH COLUMN	
PROOF OF IDENTITY	PROOF OF RESIDENCY <small>must be current with applicant's name and Norwalk address</small>
Government Forms with applicant's name and address	Norwalk Tax Bill for residence, not property or business owned
Employer ID with Photo	Utility Bill
School ID with photo	Lease
Alien Registration with Photo	Personal Mail
US Military Card with Photo	Auto Registration

Library cards expire after six years.

There is no charge to renew a card. The replacement fee for a lost library card is \$2.00.

If the applicant is a **resident of another town in Connecticut**, the applicant must bring a current (unexpired) hometown library card with a photo ID and proof of residency in order to check out materials from the Norwalk Public Library System. The expiration date is set by the hometown library.

If the applicant is **employed or attend school in Norwalk**, but are a resident of another town, the applicant may be issued a library card for use only in the Norwalk Public Library System that is renewable after one year.

**IF THE APPLICANT DOES NOT HAVE A PHOTO ID,
BORROWING PRIVILEGES WILL BE LIMITED TWO ITEMS.**
